FEEDING THE HUNGRY: MONTHLY SANDWICH COLLECTION

The ImmaCare Shelter in Hartford has an outreach program that takes food to homeless people who do not find a place at the shelter. They may be living in a car or under a bridge. The need is great, but thanks to contributions from volunteer "sandwich makers," ImmaCare can provide help and comfort to these people. Making sandwiches is a good way to involve younger family members in this ministry. The older grades of Corpus Christi School make sandwiches during the school year. The collection occurs the first weekend of the month, unless there is a holiday, then the collection is the following weekend.

Making Sandwiches:

- Any type of bread may be used.
- Two (2) slices of meat (such as ham, turkey, bologna, salami) & a slice of cheese per sandwich
- About one pound of meat is needed for a loaf of bread. You can vary the ingredients if you don't have enough of one kind to finish the loaf.
- Please DO NOT put condiments or butter on the bread.
- Peanut butter & jelly sandwiches are also very popular.
- Sandwiches are individually wrapped, put back in the bread wrapper, twist-tied.

Sandwich Delivery:

- For Corpus Christi Church, the sandwiches are brought to the Narthex and placed in the bin at any Corpus Mass.
- For Incarnation Church, the sandwiches are brought to Father Crawford Hall at any Incarnation Mass. The sandwiches are collected by Religious Education Confirmation students during the school year and are then placed in the Father Crawford Hall kitchen fridge. If no one is there to collect the sandwiches, please put them in the hall kitchen fridge.
- Up to 50 loaves of sandwiches will be picked up at Corpus by Tony Mack from ImmaCare on the Monday after the collection. The balance will remain in the Father Crawford Hall fridge. The House of Bread will pick these up, the Monday after the collection.
